ABOUT US

Special Education services are provided to students with a documented disability that require the services of a qualified special education service provider. We also offer support for students with formal accommodation plans from public and private schools. Support services include collaborative intervention services with students, teachers, counselors and parents including effective instructional/learning strategies for students with learning differences.

TESTING ACCOMODATIONS



as listed in the student's IEP, ISP, or formal accommodation plan

SPEECH LANGUAGE SERVICES



designed to help meet the needs of students with diagnosed language, articulation, voice, and/or fluency disorders who need speech/language services

RELATED SERVICES



as written in the student's IEP (school psychologist services, occupational therapy, physical therapy, audiology, transition services)

EVALUATIONS



including re-evaluations for students who already receive services and initial evaluations for students who are suspected of having a disability based upon student's difficulty making progress in the general education curriculum

APPLICATION PROCESS

Follow the registration process used by all students seeking admission. In the application, click the box to indicate that your son is currently receiving intervention services.

Submit the following items in hard copy or by email to the Admissions Office no later than December 17, 2021:

- copy of the student's most recent Evaluation Team Report (ETR), completed within the past three years
- copy of the student's current IEP, ISP, or accommodation/intervention plan with area of disability documented

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

JON PETERSON & AUTISM

In order to qualify for the Jon Peterson Special Needs Scholarship or the Autism Scholarship through the Ohio Department of Education, students must have a current ETR and IEP/ISP. Scholarship amounts are based on the student's disability category.

At La Salle, the scholarship is used to pay for special education services first, at an hourly rate. The amount is estimated before the school year starts. If there is money left over from the scholarship, this generally can be applied to the tuition account, balanced against any grant and aid. More details can be found in La Salle's Special Education Handbook.

The application period opens **February 1** for the Jon Peterson Scholarship and **April 1** for the Autism Scholarship.

La Salle will contact families with eligible students in February with instructions on how to apply for the appropriate scholarship.
