

## **Primary Function**

He/she oversees the quality of educational programs, finance, advancement functions, facility management and improvements, and campus ministry and service programs. This position is responsible for assuring the effective operation of all aspects of the organization. He/She is responsible for the fiscal policy of the school, ultimately assuring the financial health of the school and leading the school towards growth and sustainable longevity. As the leader of an excellent institution of education for young men, the President will continuously work to retain and engage activity among Alumni and friends of the La Salle community at large.

The President plays an active role in advancement, community relations, and alumni relations. He/She oversees the mission effectiveness of the school in keeping with the Catholic teachings of the Archdiocese. He/she lives in accordance to the charism of St. John Baptiste de La Salle in union with the Christian Brotherhood community.

- Demonstrated skills in financial management overseeing a revenue and expense budget paired with the ability to prioritize expenses

- Ability to teambuild and effectively collaborate with others to achieve common goals

- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to work inclusively within a diverse community
- Understanding of the charism of the Christian Brotherhood, the benefits of a Lasallian education, and a true passion for the excellent product of an all-male Catholic education.

The Principal, Director of Finance, and Director of Advancement report to the President who, in turn, offers regular updates to the Board of Limited Jurisdiction to ensure goals are meeting the vision and direction of the organization.
