The principal will report to the president and oversee all student programming, faculty development and student affairs. Both positions share the responsibility of advancing the Catholic mission and preparing young men to meet their full potential. We are grateful for Principal Marshall's leadership as we continue to make tremendous strides at La Salle. He has expressed his excitement and is committed to supporting the transition and onboarding of the president.

The search for La Salle's president will begin in October with the goal of announcing the inaugural president in January 2023. The search will be comprehensive to ensure that La Salle's first president embodies the spirit of St. John Baptist de La Salle. The board is committed to executing this process with communication, access and support from the La Salle community.
