Due to the scope of the retreat and the location of the retreat facility, we ask that each student be dropped off here at La Salle High School by no later than 6:30am. The bus will leave promptly at 6:45am for the retreat facility. The retreat will be directed by the La Salle High School Campus Ministry personnel and the Camp Kern staff, yet it will be lead by the senior students.

We ask you to please make sure your son has completed his tshirt size for his Sophomore Retreat tshirt. The student retreat fee for each one-day, off-campus Sophomore Retreat, including all expenses associated with the food, transportation, tshirt, challenge ropes and retreat program materials is **\$80 per student**. *This fee will be billed via the FACTS student billing system on Friday, September 3, and you will have several months to complete your son’s retreat payment.* Please know that there is retreat financial aid available for those who might be in need.
