It is hard to believe that graduation is just a little over two weeks away! The next two weeks are full of exams and events and hopefully a bit of fun! Below are updates to the upcoming events, please let me know if you have any questions.

Senior exam schedule

Exams are scheduled for May 19 and 20.

- Monday Wednesday will follow a normal 7-bell schedule
- Thursday odd bell exams
- Friday even bell exams. Students in all grades will be dismissed at 1:14 pm
- Seniors are only required to report to the bells for which they have an exam.
- Any senior who has an A average in a course for the year will be exempt from the final exam in that particular course with approval from their teacher and administration. They will not have to report to school for those exams.
- The cafeteria will be open all week.
- Students who miss an exam are expected to make it up on Monday, May 23. Seniors who do not have a make-up exam do not need to report to school.
- The last day of school for seniors is Tuesday, May 24 (senior picnic).

Mom Prom - 5/21

We look forward to seeing you on Saturday, May 21, 2022, from 7:00 - 9:00 pm in the La Salle gym for Mom Prom! The cost is \$40 for two and \$20 for one. Tickets can be purchased here. Dress is cocktail attire. Dessert will be served.

Senior Declarations and Awards - 5/23

Senior Declarations and Awards are on Monday, May 23 at 6:30 pm. Attendance is mandatory. Students should arrive between 6:00 and 6:15 pm and check in to their assigned classroom. They should be seated in the gym no later than 6:15 pm. Students and two guests will be seated on the floor in the gym for the awards ceremony. Students may have other family members attend, but they will be seated in the bleachers. The awards ceremony will last approximately 30 minutes. At the conclusion of the awards, students and their guests will disperse to their assigned room with their mentor where they will present their Senior Declaration and will receive additional awards and cords they have earned. Once all students in the room have presented, students and families are invited to the cafeteria for treats provided by the La Salle Parent Council. Thank you, LPC. Dress for students is Mass attire with dress shoes.

Mass of Thanksgiving and Senior Picnic - 5/24

Students should arrive at school by 8:00 am for The Mass of Thanksgiving on Tuesday, May 24. After Mass, seniors will be bused to the Knights of Columbus facility to celebrate their time together as brothers at La Salle. At the conclusion of the picnic, students will be bused back to La Salle where they will be dismissed. Dress is casual, students should wear their senior t-shirt.

Graduation Practice - 5/27

All seniors are required to attend graduation practice on Friday, May 27 at 9:00 am. Practice will end by 11:30 am. Students may wear La Salle spirit wear and shorts. Students will receive their parking passes and graduation tickets at the conclusion of graduation practice. Tickets and passes will not be distributed beforehand. Attendance is mandatory.

Graduation day details - 5/29

- The gates will open at 5:30 pm. Students should arrive at La Salle at 6:00 p.m. to allow time to park. Each family is issued two parking passes for entrance into the La Salle parking lot. We encourage seniors to arrive with their parents. Please know, no cars will be permitted in the La Salle parking lot without a valid Graduation Day parking pass. Parking will also be available on the side streets near La Salle. Please note there will be no parking on Edalbert. Golf cart shuttles will be available as needed. We will have a limited amount of handicap parking spots available.
- Report to the De La Salle building multi-purpose/wrestling room to prepare for procession line-up no later than 6:15 p.m.
- As part of our partnership with Lifetouch, their photographers will be onsite at graduation taking pictures of each graduate as they receive their diploma. Signup now to receive the photo link when the photos are ready to be previewed and ordered.
- Graduates are dismissed following the conclusion of graduation
- Attendance is mandatory

Seating and graduation etiquette

- Guests should not bring noise makers of any kind, including air horns. There is to be absolutely NO confetti in Lancer Stadium. It ruins and stains the turf.
- Students should not throw their caps in the air at the commencement of graduation.
- Only ticketed guests may be seated on the floor in their student's assigned row of seating. Seating assignments will be randomly generated. Additional guests are welcome to attend open-seating in the stadium bleachers. These seats are unassigned/not ticketed and are available on a first-come, first-served.
- · Ticketed guests in wheelchairs may be seated on the field in place of a chair. Non-ticketed guests in wheelchairs will be seated on the track.

Graduation contingency plan

We are praying for fantastic weather, in the event that we need to make adjustments, our contingency plan is A) push the time of graduation back, but still occuring on May 29, (if there is temporary inclement weather) or B) move graduation to Monday, May 30 at 11:00 am (if the weather does not cooperate on May 29).
