- 1. Class size will be limited to the first 20 paid registrants.
- 2. Registration is open August 22 -September 6.
- 3. The fee for the course is \$375. Practice materials will be provided for the students.
- 4. If there are still openings, late registrations will be accepted with a late fee of \$400.
- 5. The entire fee must be submitted before the student is allowed to attend the course.


