- All students are expected to arrive at school on time Friday, Monday, and Tuesday and are expected to report to the exam bells accordingly.
- During exam bells, students are to be engaged in instructional activities for the duration of the bell, and students who finish their exam early are to remain in the classroom for the entire block of time to minimize hallway disruptions.
- Students may leave school at the conclusion of an exam bell if that is their last exam of the day.
- The cafeteria will not be open for lunch on exam days, but the cafeteria staff will be offering grab-and-go items for students.
