- During exam bells, students are to be engaged in instructional activities for the duration of the bell, and students who finish their exam early are to remain in the classroom for the entire block of time to minimize hallway disruptions.
- Students may leave school at the conclusion of an exam bell if that is their last exam of the day.
- The cafeteria will not be open for lunch on exam days, but the cafeteria staff will be offering grab-and-go items for students.

La Salle High School offers an ACT Intensive Prep Course. This course is especially offered for juniors who will be taking the ACT at La Salle on **Tuesday, March 14**. Those who are sophomores are also invited to take the course, especially since sophomores will be taking the PreACT on March 14. As well, the course will prepare students for future ACTs.
