University of Cincinnati: NO ACT required
 Miami (Oxford) University: NO ACT required
 University of Dayton: NO ACT required
 Mount St. Joseph University: ACT optional
 Northern Kentucky University: ACT optional
 Ohio State University: ACT optional
 Ohio University: ACT optional or Composite of 21 or higher

We want you to be aware of this information so that you can make an informed decision regarding this Fall's ACT Prep Course.

Fall Dates for the ACT Prep Course are on **Tuesdays, 3:15-5:30 p.m.** to prepare for the **October 22 ACT**:

- **September 13, 20, 27**
- **October 4, 11, 18**

Registration:

1. Class size will be limited to the first 20 paid registrants.
2. Registration is open **August 22 –September 6.**
3. The fee for the course is \$375. Practice materials will be provided for the students.
4. If there are still openings, late registrations will be accepted with a late fee of \$400.
5. The entire fee must be submitted before the student is allowed to attend the course.

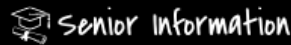
Crime Stoppers Shred-It Volunteers Needed - Saturday, 9/17/22
