Our annual Canned Food Drive wrapped up last week, collecting a total of 39,547 pounds throughout the six-night collection! We had 346 students volunteer, totalling 1038 hours volunteered!






Service hours

As we head into the holiday season, please remember to report COVID-19 cases to the school nurse, Susan Geoppinger at 513-741-2302. Due to new quarantining rules (mask to stay/mask to play), parents have options which minimize or eliminate quarantine times for school and school-related activities. By notifying the nurse of a positive case, you are keeping all students and their families safe and informed of possible exposures. It doesn't always mean large groups of students will have to miss school or activities.

We are finishing up the first drug test for each student this year. All results of passing tests go to parent one in Final Forms and a copy is sent to your son. A failing test result will be handled by the student's counselor. One third of all students will receive a random drug test during the second semester.
