
#### Ensemble sign-ups

The Pride of La Salle is now holding signups for the Wind and Percussion Ensembles and Winter Guard. Interested students can sign up in the band room on the sign-up sheet. If you have any questions, please reach out to Mr. Schwartz.

Wind Ensemble is open to all woodwind, brass and percussion players. Students must have at least one year in band previously or are currently involved in a band class. This ensemble will perform miniature tours to local elementary schools, high schools, and other venues. The wind ensemble meets once a week after school. The day and time will be determined after sign-ups are complete.

Percussion Ensemble is open to all percussionists, experience preferred but not necessary. This is a competitive group that will attend two to three local competitions this year. It is considered an indoor drumline group which also includes instruments such as piano, marimba and other auxiliary instruments. This ensemble meets once a week after school. Winter Guard is open to anyone, dance/guard experience preferred but not necessary. This is a group geared more toward beginners and students who are relatively new to color guard.
