### Catholic Schools Week - 1/31 - 2/4

Next week, we will celebrate Catholic Schools Week. We will begin our school-wide service project, collecting toiletry items for St. Vincent de Paul and will be having our annual penny wars, donating monies raised to the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. Students are encouraged to bring in toiletry  $items\ to\ donate\ and\ coins\ for\ the\ penny\ wars.\ Items\ will\ be\ collected\ each\ morning\ in\ the\ courtyard\ lobby\ from\ 7:00\ -\ 7:55\ am.$ 

The senior leaders have planned theme days for students next week to celebrate Catholic Schools Week. ### **ACT Prep Course**

On Wednesday, March 16, 2022, La Salle juniors will be taking an official, state-funded ACT provided through the State of Ohio in conjunction with the ACT organization. The results of this test can be submitted with students' college applications in their senior year. Students may choose to

take additional ACT tests outside of the March 16 date. Students will need to pay the \$60 registration fee for any additional tests. The \$60 fee for the test is without the writing/essay portion, which most universities do not require.

Though it is never required for testing, La Salle is offering an ACT Prep Course prior to the March 16 ACT. Test preparation is no different than any other skill: the more the student intently learns and practices, the better the student should become. Our approach involves testing, skills review, problem-solving concepts and strategies and practice materials.

The course will consist of six sessions from 3:15 - 5:30 pm on Tuesday afternoons:

- February 8
- February 15
- February 22
- March 1
- March 8
- March 15

These sessions are intended to prepare the students for the ACT on March 16 as well as for future ACTs. The course cost is \$385 which includes the textbook. Registration information for the course is now available. January 31, 2022 is the last day to register without a late fee. Beginning February 1, 2022, the fee will remain \$385 but will not include the textbook. Questions or concerns, please contact Kathy Moroney. Students who have previously taken the course are reminded that they may attend all or some of the sessions with no additional fees.

### Last reminder - job opportunity: umpires needed

The Cincinnati Western Baseball Conference (CWBC) is seeking umpires for the 2022 baseball season. The CWBC season runs from March 26, 2022 through the end of June. Umpire training classes are scheduled to be held on the Saturday mornings of February 26, March 5 and March 12 from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm at Our Lady of Victory cafeteria. On-field sessions are scheduled for March 18, 19 and 20 at Our Lady of Visitation fields.

Umpires must be at least a freshman in high school and have reliable transportation to and from games. No prior experience as an umpire is required, but a working knowledge of baseball is strongly recommended. New umpires are required to attend each of the three classroom sessions and at least one of the on-field sessions. Returning umpires are encouraged to attend the classroom sessions and the on-field sessions. The cost for the training is

\$20 for new umpires. New umpires will be responsible for purchasing their umpire apparel and gear. Umpire fees will start at \$40 per game for the 2022 season. If interested, please send an email with your contact information to Rob Reid, CWBC Umpire Coordinator.


