It's that time of year again! The BDK Fund is now accepting scholarship applications for the 2022-23 academic year. Newly-accepted and returning high school students are eligible to apply for The BDK Scholars Program with scholarships starting at \$1000. They are seeking students who are passionate about community service and who are in need of fulfilling their financial obligation to their high school. Scholarships awarded this spring are intended to support a student's 2022-23 tuition. Applicants will be notified of their application status by **March 31, 2022**.

Standardized testing - 3/15

On **Tuesday, March 15, 2022**, all juniors will be taking the state sponsored ACT. Parents do not need to register or pay for this test. Sophomores will take the pre-ACT and freshmen will take the IOWA test as part of their graduation pathway requirements. Seniors will be not report to school and can schedule a college visit or a career exploration day.

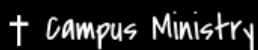
**Bidding update**

Annual Men's Conference - 4/2

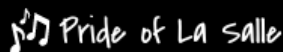
