End of the quarter and dress code changes - 3/11

The end of the third quarter is Friday, March 11, 2022. Per the student handbook, students may wear uniform shorts or uniform pants beginning the first day of the fourth quarter, Monday, March 14, 2022. Students must also wear a La Salle polo or a white button-down Oxford shirt without any emblems or logos. Students may no longer wear hooded sweatshirts Monday - Thursday, but instead may wear 1/4 zip over their uniform top. On Fridays, students may wear any La Salle branded top with uniform bottoms. Lancer Fridays will be communicated by the senior leaders.

Standardized testing - 3/15

Tuesday, March 15, 2022, is testing day at La Salle. Seniors will have the day off and should not report to school. All tests for underclassmen will begin at 8:00 a.m. Students should report directly to their testing room upon arrival. Students who arrive after test booklets are handed out will not be permitted to test, so being on time is important.

- Freshmen will take the IOWA test and dismiss around 12:15 p.m.
- · Sophomores will take the PreACT and dismiss around 10:45 a.m.
- Juniors will take the ACT and dismiss at about 11:30 a.m.

These dismissal times are approximate within a few minutes depending on lines for restroom breaks, etc. If your student receives accommodations, their intervention specialist will notify you of their specific dismissal time directly.


