Standardized testing - 3/15

Tuesday, March 15, 2022, is testing day at La Salle. Seniors will have the day off and should not report to school. All tests for underclassmen will begin at 8:00 a.m. Students should report directly to their testing room upon arrival. Students who arrive after test booklets are handed out will not be permitted to test, so being on time is important.

- Freshmen will take the IOWA test and dismiss around 12:15 pm
- Sophomores will take the PreACT and dismiss around 10:45 am
- . Juniors will take the ACT and dismiss at about 11:30 am

These dismissal times are approximate within a few minutes depending on lines for restroom breaks, etc. If your student receives accommodations, their intervention specialist will notify you of their specific dismissal time directly.




