- Exams are set for May 19 and 20.
  - Monday Wednesday will follow a normal 7-bell schedule
  - Thursday odd bell exams
  - Friday even bell exams. Students in all grades will be dismissed at 12:44 pm
- Seniors are only required to report to the bells for which they have an exam.
- Any senior who has an A average in a course for the year will be exempt from the final exam in that particular course with approval from their teacher and administration. They will not have to report to school for those exams.

- Students who miss an exam are expected to make it up on Monday, May 23.
- The last day of school for seniors is Tuesday, May 24 (senior picnic).

### ACT Prep Course - registration now open

In March, La Salle juniors took an official, state-funded ACT provided through the State of Ohio in conjunction with the ACT organization. If students/parents are satisfied with the results of this test, these results can be submitted withyour sons' college applications in his senior year.

Students who wish to retake the ACT test may do so, but they are responsible for the registration fee for any addional tests. The current fee is \$60 for the test without the writing/essay portion, which most universities do not require.

Though it is never required for testing, La Salle is offering an ACT Prep Course prior to the July 16 and the September (TBD) ACTs. Our approach involves testing, skills review, problem-solving concepts and strategies and practice materials.

The course will consist of five sessions from 9:30 am-12:00 pm on the following Tuesdays:

- June 14
- June 21
- June 28 July 5
- July 12

The class size will be limited to the first 15 paid registrants. Registration is open through May 24, 2022. Please click here to register. The fee for the course is \$365, which also includes practice materials that will be made available to the students. If there are still openings, late registrations will be accepted with the same fee of \$365. The entire fee must be submitted before the student will be allowed to attend the course. Students who have previously taken the course may attend again without charge, but they must contact Mrs. Moroney. Post-registration, a student and his parents will be required to sign a commitment form, which will be provided after registration and must be submitted at the first session so that the student is able to continue to participate in the classes.

### Service hours



### Vaccine reminder for parents of class of 2022

Ohio's immunization law requires that all students entering 12th grade must have received two (2) doses of the MCV4 (meningococcal serogroup A,C,W and Y) vaccine (for Meningitis).

Please note:

- \* The second dose must be given on or after the 16th birthday
- \* There must be at least 8 weeks between the first and second dose
- \* If the first dose was given on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

Your current 11th-grade son will need to show documentation of having received these immunizations by the time he returns to school in the fall. Please notify the school nurse if your son has already received the Meningitis vaccine(s), or to make arrangements for your son to receive the immunizations before the "rush" this summer. If your son has already received the vaccines please send an updated immunization record to the nurse either through email sgeoppinger@lasallehs.net or fax to 513-741-2357.

If your son has not already received the vaccines, please contact your son's doctor/clinic to schedule an appointment. The Health Department provides the vaccine either free, for a nominal charge for children without insurance, or with Medicaid insurance. You may reach the Health Department at 513-946-7882 for additional information and their immunization clinic schedule.


# Virtual Blood Drive - now through 5/31
