Picture day for all students and staff is August 23. The order form will be shared next week.


Senior yearbook photos

ACT Intensive Prep Course

This course is specially offered for seniors and juniors who will be taking the ACT on Saturday, October 23, 2021. As well, the course will prepare students for the ACT in December and February (or the SAT in November and December).

We have found the course to be most beneficial for students who are personally motivated to devote the time required for the sessions. Test preparation is no different than any other skill: The more the student learns and practices, the better the student becomes. Based on this premise, La Salle is offering a focused, standardized, test preparation course. Our approach involves testing, skills review, problem-solving concepts and strategies, and practice materials. (The majority of these skills and strategies can also be transferred to the SAT.)

The Fall ACT will meet on Tuesday afternoons, from 3:15-5:30 on the following dates: September 14, September 21, and September 29; October 5, October 12, and October 19.

Registration information:

- 1. Class size will be limited to the first 20 paid registrants.
- 2. Registration is open August 17 September 7.
- 3. The fee for the course is \$375, which also includes the purchase of an ACT textbook. If the student already owns the textbook or wants to purchase his own copy, the fee would be \$350.
- 4. If there are still openings, late registrations will be accepted with the same fee of \$375, but the student will need to purchase his own ACT book as the texts will have already been ordered for the course.
- 5. The entire fee must be submitted before the student will be allowed to attend the course.
- 6. The student must personally register online for the actual ACT and SAT tests as these require credit card and personal information.
- 7. Students who have previously taken our course may attend again without charge, but they must register. Please contact Mrs. Moroney directly at kmoroney@lasallehs.net.


Christian service hours

La Salle COVID-19 Policy 2021-2022

La Salle High School will follow current health department guidelines in regard to COVID-19 for the 2021-22 school year. We will update our policy and guidance based on changes made by local officials.

Vaccinations are strongly encouraged but not mandatory. Vaccinations can be received at Walgreens, CVS, Mercy Health, Kroger and other sites throughout the city. Most retailers offer walk-in appointments. Please visit Test and Protect Cincinnati to find a site near you.

La Salle will not require masks for on-campus and school-sponsored events. Individuals may choose to wear a mask in any setting. Parents/guardians should discuss their personal mask-wearing expectations with their son(s).

Based upon current guidance from Hamilton County Public Health:

- Fully vaccinated individuals will not need to quarantine if exposed to COVID-19 unless symptoms are present. Vaccinated individuals who test positive will need to quarantine and their close contacts will also be required to quarantine
- Unvaccinated, unmasked individuals may need to quarantine if exposed to COVID-19. Since masks are not required, classroom quarantines for close contacts would take effect again individuals within 6ft for 15 minutes of exposure over 48 hours are considered close contacts.

La Salle will continue to offer sanitization stations throughout our building, provide increased sanitization by our maintenance staff and maintain classroom sanitization supplies.

Students should stay home when ill.

- If a student is unvaccinated and exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 he should seek care from a healthcare provider.
- If a student has symptoms of a gastrointestinal disorder or fever he should stay home until symptoms resolve for 24 hours.
- If a student has missed class due to illness, a note should be provided to the school nurse upon return to school.

For students missing school due to COVID-19 or a quarantine period, the regular sick policy for attendance will be followed. We are not offering online class options this school year.

Class of 2025 vaccination records

Incoming freshmen will need to provide a copy of their immunizations to the school nurse by the first day of school. They can be dropped off to the main office, faxed from your doctor to 513-741-2357 or emailed to the school nurse at sgeoppinger@lasallehs.net.

Vaccine reminder for parents of class of 2022

Ohio's immunization law requires that all students entering 12th grade must have received two (2) doses of the MCV4 (meningococcal serogroup A,C,W and Y) vaccine (for Meningitis).

Please note:

- * The second dose must be given on or after the 16th birthday
- * There must be at least 8 weeks between the first and second dose
- * If the first dose was given on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

Your current 11th-grade son will need to show documentation of having received these immunizations by the time he returns to school in the fall. If your son has already received the vaccines please send an updated immunization record to school.

If your son has not already received the vaccines, please contact your son's doctor/clinic to schedule an appointment. The Health Department provides the vaccine either free, for a nominal charge for children without insurance, or with Medicaid insurance. You may reach the Health Department at 513-946-7882 for additional information and their immunization clinic schedule.
