No school, professional development - 10/18


There will be no school for students on October 18 as faculty and staff participate in professional development and attend the School of Faith. The school office will also be closed.

Aramark breakfast and lunch menus are now available online, which include daily featured items and nutritional information.




Golf Team - golfers receive GCL honors
