Mr. Kevin Higgins is bringing his years of experience to our social studies department and will also be teaching a section of religion. In addition, he'll be our varsity boys basketball coach and help out in our admissions department. He's entering the vacancy left by Mr. Harmon who filled in for us last semester.

Mr. Kunkel is moving from the math department to use his MBA as an adjunct professor for UC's Lindner College of Business for those classes offered here this year. Mr. Joe Tunney, who has spent two years in the classroom after taking an early retirement from the business world, will be filling his role in the math department.

With the departure of Mrs. Webb and Mr. Strotman, we'll be replacing our Spanish department. Ms. Karen Rosen and Ms. Sarah Townsley will be filling these roles. While Ms. Rosen is new to the field,

Ms. Townsley brings multiple years of experience. Both of these women are native speakers and bring a breadth of experiences to La Salle.

Our Vocal Ensemble Director will be Ms. Kat Ullery. Our thespians remember her from her assistance with our production of "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat" last spring. She'll also be filling in as a day-to-day sub in the building.

Ms. Ashley Saccaggi brings her public school experience in teaching biology to fill the vacancy left by Mrs. Terri Moore. She's excited to bring her talents to our faith-based institution.

Ms. Gail Dorsey will be the new school counselor, taking over for Mrs. Jess Fager. Mrs. Dorsey has years of experience with the Hamilton County Educational Service Center that she brings our way.

We'll have some pretty significant changes in our student services department. Filling the position held by Ms. Christina Fisk-Jackson is Ms. Leah Holland. She'll help with interventions and with students on service plans. Cody Smith brings his experience as an intervention specialist in Indiana to join Mr. Majors in working with our IEP students. He's also coaching football with Mr. Majors. This is a position that did not exist last year. Also in a new position is Ms. Kim Hummons who will be joining us 4 days per week as a math specialist. With these professionals, we expect to be able to have them "push-in" services into most classrooms rather than pulling our young men out to work with them. This also provides the advantage to other students in the class to receive assistance as needed rather than just the students identified as having needs.

Later this week, we will be sharing with you our Advancing the Brotherhood Strategic Plan, which is the result of the listening and feedback sessions held earlier this year. Please be on the lookout for this email on Friday. Next month, we'll tell you about the improvements made to our learning, cafeteria, and athletic spaces as well as classroom and department moves.
