LaSalle Band Invitation Car, Bus and Truck Parking Instructions

All Drivers

Thank you for attending the LaSalle Band Invitational. We hope your band, and band supporters, enjoys our invitational. We need you to be aware LaSalle High School is parking challenged on invitational days. There is no personal parking on site and the site is 100% utilized for Trucks, Busses, Staff and Handicap parking. Invitational day can be confusing so <u>please read the following instructions carefully before leaving your school.</u>

Personal Cars - Non-Handicapped

We have two remote lots for parking which we highly encourage you instruct your band supporters to use. Print out the map for your drive and proceed directly to the remote lots. Busses are free and run the entire duration of the event. There is side-street parking available but it is very limited and you will find the lots more time effective. Please allow an additional 20 min from the lot to your entering the invitational.

Personal Cars – Handicapped

There will be some parking available on site for personal cars with a current Handicap tag. The spaces available will NOT be ADA Handicap compliant but as close to front gate as we can get you.

Bus Drivers

Busses will arrive and turn into LaSalle off of North Bend Road, meet the Parking Boss and then be directed to the Cyan Bus Discharge area in front of the school. Once the students are off the bus, the busses will leave LaSalle temporarily (red arrows) and then park. <u>If your band is staying till the end</u> and there is parking available the bus will loop back to the primary entrance and then follow the blue lines back to the green Primary Bus Parking area. The Backlot Boss will meet you and provide instructions on where to park. <u>If your band is leaving before the end</u> or there is no parking available, the bus will turn left on North Bend drive to Kroger Parking lot at the corner of North Bend and Cheviot, turn around in the lot and return Eastbound on North Bend. A lane on North Bend will be blocked off for busses to park in (orange area). Drivers are to pull forward to the rear of the bus in front. Drivers can return to LaSalle and relax in the hospitality suite for the duration of the event.

At the end of the evening. Participants will load into all the busses parked in the Primary Bus Parking area and then leave sequentially once the busses are full and the bus ahead of you leaves. For busses that are parked on the street, once the last band LaSalle leaves the pit area, busses can enter LaSalle grounds and park in the pit area for loading once the invitational is over. If you are directed to the street, see Parking Boss after you park on the street for instructions at the end of the evening.

Truck (Equipment) Drivers

Early smaller bands will likely be directed to the St. Joes lot. This allows you more room for staging and frees up space in the back lot for late arriving large bands. If you are directed via email before the invitational, the Equipment Drivers can proceed directly to the St. Joes lot. You will be directed by the St. Joes Boss on where to park.

All remaining bands will arrive and turn into LaSalle off of North Bend Road, meet the Parking Boss and then be directed to the Purple Primary Band Truck area in back of the school.
